

Nebraska County Bridge Match Program | Broken Bow, NE

Double 82" Arched CMP with Headwalls and Wingwalls

Application

Removed an old 25' timber bridge that was in poor condition and replaced with a set of two 82" Arched corrugated steel pipe with headwalls and wingwalls.

Special/unique elements of the project

The Nebraska County Bridge Match Program, which was created as a result of the Transportation Innovation Act, signed into law in April 2016 by Governor Ricketts. \$40 million has been dedicated to program to pilot innovative solutions to help repair or replace critical bridges on county road systems. So far, 68 bridges across the state have been selected.

Custer County is home to the first bridge receiving funding from the program. A 25-foot timber bridge located near Broken Bow will be replaced with two 84-inch round equivalent culvert pipes with headwalls and wing wall construction provided by TrueNorth Steel.



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
