



WELDER TRAINING SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

- To participate in the TNS Welder Training Scholarship Program you must pass all pre-employment screenings such as Background Checks, Physicals and Drug Screening.
- TNS covers a portion of the program costs, and the additional costs are funded by the ND Career Builders Scholarship Program. You are required to maintain an overall grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 or over to receive the ND Career Builders Scholarship. Please refer to the information on the ND Career Building application for more detailed information.
- Candidates will need to be over 18 years of age by the start date of the class enrolled in. Candidates must also adhere to admission requirements of Lynnes Welding Training to be granted entrance into the welding program. A copy of High School Diploma/GED is required for entrance into the Lynnes Welding Training program.
- TrueNorth Steel will provide all PPE required for work except Steel Toe Boots. By your first day at TrueNorth Steel you will need to have steel toe boots. 5-inch boots for women and 6-inch boots for men. Ask about our reimbursement and payroll deduction program.
- The selection process will include a short sit down interview, shop tour and 3 year Tuition Assistance Agreement to work at TrueNorth Steel prior to course completion.
